

For you to work under an individual practitioner in private practice, as under Dr. Mora, PLLC, you must have completed and graduated from a program accredited by COAMFTE with a master's or doctoral degree in marriage and family therapy (*not currently be a student*) and registered as an LMFT-A with the State of Texas.

The LMFT Associate license allows you to begin accruing the supervised clinical experience necessary to become a full Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist (LMFT). You must be registered as having taken or currently registered for the jurisprudence and LMFT examinations. You must also have secured your professional liability insurance before you may obtain supervisory hours under an LMFT-S such as Dr. Mora.
